Agriculture is a key sector most developing countries: it accounts for more than half of overall employment in most of the LDCs (55% in 2019), and employs 70% of the rural poor.

Growth in the agriculture sector is 2-4 X more effective in raising incomes among the poorest compared to other sectors.

Globally, less than 10% of government expenditure is dedicated to agriculture. In Africa, governments spend less than 4% of their budgets on average to support agriculture.

- Agriculture generates 19-29% of total greenhouse gas (GHG) emissions.
- At the same time, climate change is one of the major factors affecting the productivity of agricultural production in many developing countries.
- Thus, we urgently have to ensure that our global food system becomes sustainable and climate-resilient.
- One way of achieving this would be to re-purpose the US\$ 1.8 trillion currently spent as subsidies to environmentally polluting practices (including US\$ 520 billion on agriculture) to support sustainable farming practices.
